People reached were 373982

People who accepted Christ were 12788

People who renewed were 17336

127 moslems have converted to Christianity this year 2023.

67 Adventists have converted to the Anglican church in South Rwenzori Diocese.

RE: MISSION AND EVANGELISM REPORT 2023.

Glory be to God our father through Jesus Christ. We really thank God who has enabled us reach the end of this year, 2023.

As mission and evangelism department, we thank the Bishop, South Rwenzori Diocese, all staff and partners in ministry for the prayers and support which they have rendered towards our activities done in 2023.

Below are some of the achievements:

We have trained 1775 evangelists in discipleship and evangelism Level I and II in life ministry curriculum.

We have trained 1265 church leaders in standing strong through the storm.

We conducted the training of serving the persecuted church practical approach to 560 church leaders.

We launched a soap making machine and Kisinga Archdeaconry is operating it now.

We conducted a Diocesan Annual Prayer Conference which attracted over 5000 believers.

We conducted a lay readers' one day seminar which attracted 600.

We conducted Alpha Discipleship training led by regional coordinator of Africa with all Archdeacons and assistant Archdeacons.

We launched a basketball project for sport evangelism now our youth are non-redundant.

We have formed 83 clusters for the pastors equipping network for the discipleship of our church leaders.

We have formed 83 rooted in Jesus Junior for the discipleship of children and 260 have finished book one and 140 have finished book 2. Now they can memorize the verses in the bible and four of them participated in our diocesan mission.
